# Weingut *Bauer*

*Mülheim, Mosel. More than three hundred years of wine in the same family.*

The Bauer family has made wine in Mülheim in the Middle Mosel for more than three hundred years. They farm around 8 hectares of vineyard, spread across parcels in Brauneberger Juffer, Mülheimer Sonnenlay, Mülheimer and Veldenzer Elisenberg, and Veldenzer Kirchberg.

From Bauer we bring in two Spätburgunder wines: a barrel-aged red and a dry rosé from the Brauneberg parcels. We import them because they show a different side of the Mosel from the Riesling: cool-climate Pinot from a family that has done this for a long time.

## ABOUT THE WINE

Spätburgunder is German for Pinot Noir. Bauer grows the grape in the Mosel and ages the wine for a year in oak barrels, which adds vanilla and spice without taking over from the fruit. Ruby red with garnet edges. Ripe cherries, raspberries and strawberries on the nose, with a hint of vanilla. Medium-bodied, with soft tannins and fresh acidity, and a finish that pulls in the fruit and a discreet oak note.

## ABOUT THE WINE

A Spätburgunder rosé from Bauer's parcels in Brauneberg in the Middle Mosel. "Trocken" means dry: residual sugar sits at 4.2 g/l, and the 5.3 g/l acidity keeps it poised. Pale salmon. Strawberry, raspberry and white flowers on the nose. Light on the palate, with a dry, fruit-driven finish. Chill well and serve as an aperitif, or with shellfish or light meat.
